The Detecto model WACONNECT allows the simple automated interfacing between the Welch Allyn Connex® Vital Signs Monitor (Connex VSM), the Welch Allyn Connex® Integrated Wall System (Connex IWS) and DETECTO medical scales which utilize the MedVue Model MV1 Medical Weight Analyzer.

Items Included in Connectivity Kit

- 1. Welch $Allyn^{\ensuremath{ extsf{B}}}$ Authorization Code card.
- 2. USB Interface Cable, 8 Feet.

Activate Welch Allyn Device

Using the Welch Allyn[®] Service Tool program for your Welch Allyn device, enter the PLFM WEIGHT SCALE LICENSE number exactly as shown on Authorization Code card.



Connect Welch Allyn Device and Detecto Scale

Once the license number is accepted by the device, connect the USB cable to the device and the scale.

- 1. Loosen screw and open USB connector door.
- 2. Plug-in USB cable provided by Detecto.
- 3. Close USB connector door and secure cable by tightening screw.
- 4. Plug-in USB cable into MedVue USB port.











Verify that the Welch Allyn settings have been selected in the MedVue setup. Refer to the MedVue Model MV1 Medical Weight Analyzer Owner's Manual, 8555-M512-O1 and APPENDIX B (Connecting to a Welch Allyn CVSM Device) for additional information.

Operation

The Weight and Height (if applicable) will automatically be transmitted from the scale to the Welch Allyn device when the weight on the scale stabilizes and the Stable \blacktriangle annunciator turns on.
